
JACKSON COUNTY CEMETERIES



ANTELOPE CEMETERY

From Medford take Hwy 62 to Hwy 140. Turn right on Hwy 140 and go 3.6 miles to Riley Road. Turn left on Riley Road and go for 1.2 miles. The cemetery is on the right, just past the intersection with Alta Vista. Antelope Cemetery was established in 1854. Location: N42° 26.75′ W122° 46.934′

ANTIOCH CEMETERY From Medford take Table Rock Road and go 7.5 miles to Modoc Road. Turn right on Modoc Road and go 1.8 miles to Antioch Road. Turn left on Antioch Road and go for 3.7 miles. Antioch Cemetery will be on the right after you cross Hwy 234. Antioch Cemetery was established in 1867. Location: N42° 30.274′ W122° 54.088′





ASHLAND CEMETERY

From downtown Ashland go south on Main Street. Continue on East Main for two blocks after the intersection with Siskiyou Blvd. Ashland Cemetery was established in 1870. The cemetery will be on the right. Ashland Cemetery was established in 1870. Location: N42° 11.660′ W122° 42.331′

AUNT CAROLINE'S PARK

From Medford, go north on Hwy 62 past the Shady Cove city limits. The park is at the intersection of Indian Creek Road and Hwy 62. It is on the right before you reach the Rogue River. There are only memorials here, no burials. This is a Shady Cove city park. Location: N42° 36.623′ W122° 48.754′





BROWNSBORO CEMETERY

From Medford take Hwy 62. In White City turn right on Hwy 140 and go 8½ miles to Brownsboro. Turn left on Obenchain Road (past Meridian Rd). Cross a small bridge and immediately bear left on the dirt road in front of the Community Bulletin Board. Bear left at every Y in the road for 0.4 miles (do not go into the driveway of the last house before the cemetery). Brownsboro Cemetery was established in 1854 (the gate says 1913). Location: N42° 28.370′ W122° 42.649′

BUTTE FALLS CEMETERY

From Hwy 62, turn onto the Butte Falls Hwy and go 13.6 miles to Obenchain Road. Turn right onto Obenchain Road and go ½ mile. The cemetery is on the left. Butte Falls Cemetery was established in 1868. Location: N42° 33.085′ W122° 36.267′






CENTRAL POINT IOOF CEMETERY

From Medford, go north on I-5 and take the Central Point exit #33. Turn right on Pine Street (east). Turn left on Hamrick Road. The cemetery is ½ mile down the road on the right. The earliest burial in the Central Point IOOF Cemetery was in 1866. Location: N42° 23.229′ W122° 53.531′

DUNKARD CEMETERY also known as TALENT CEMETERY or CHURCH OF THE BRETHREN CEMETERY

From Talent, take Highway 99 north. Turn left into the driveway at 5800 Highway 99. The cemetery is behind a business and down a gravel road (go to the right and behind the building). The cemetery is on the left side of the gravel road. The earliest burial in the Dunkard Cemetery was in 1890. Location: N42° 15.0291′ W122° 47.544′





EAGLE POINT NATIONAL CEMETERY

From Medford take Hwy 62 to Hwy 140. Turn right on Hwy 140 and go 3.6 miles to Riley Road. Turn left on Riley Road and go to Eagle Point National Cemetery, one of three national cemeteries in Oregon. The cemetery was established in 1952.

Location: N42° 27.687′ W122° 47.109′

EASTWOOD IOOF CEMETERY

From the center of Medford, go south on Central (Hwy 99). Turn left on 10 Street. Cross Bear Creek and continue on 10 Street. Bear to the right and you will be on Siskiyou. Turn left into the cemetery driveway just before the roundabout. Eastwood is a Medford city park. Eastwood IOOF Cemetery was established in 1890. Location: N420 19.264 W1220 51.053





ESTREMADO CEMETERY

From Medford, drive north on I-5 and take exit # 43. Exit to the right and then right again on Hwy 99. Cross the Rogue River and continue right on Hwy 234. Enter the Rock Point Pioneer Cemetery which is on the left and just across the railroad tracks. The cemetery is located on the far right (east) side of the property. Location: N42° 26.183′ W123° 04.958′

GEARY CEMETRY

From Medford, take Hwy 62 to the north. After Trail, turn left on Elk Creek Road. The cemetery is about 10½ miles up Elk Creek Road. Geary Cemetery was established around 1900.





GRIFFIN CREEK CEMETERY

From Medford, drive south on Highway 99, turn right (west) onto South Stage Road. Drive about four miles until the road intersects Griffin Creek Road. Turn left (south) on Griffin Creek Road and travel for about 1.7 miles. Turn right (west) onto Burrell Road. The cemetery is beyond the gate (private property) at 3070 Burrell Road, Medford, Oregon 97501. Go through the gate and up the hill. The cemetery is beyond the two residences on the left at end of lane. Griffin Creek Cemetery, established in 1859. Location: N42° 16.536′ W122° 54.917′

HARGADINE CEMETERY

From Medford, drive south on Hwy 99 to the Ashland city limits. After entering the North Ashland city limit, turn right on Sheridan Street. The cemetery is up the street about 800 feet and is on the right hand side. Hargadine Cemetery was established in 1850. Location: N42° 12.566′ W122° 43.646′





HAYS CEMETERY also known as HAYS AND GALLS CEMETERY

From Medford take I-5 to the Gold Hill exit # 40. Cross the overpass over I-5 and turn right onto Old Stage Road North. Go 1 ½ miles to Hodson Road. Turn left on Hodson Road and go 0.2 mile. Turn right onto a dirt driveway. The cemetery is 200 yards on the left. Hays Cemetery was established in 1856. Location: N42° 25.856′ W123° 04.479′

HILLCREST CEMETERY

From Medford, go south on Central (Hwy 99). Turn left (east) onto Barnett Road. Continue to follow Barnett Road until you reach North Phoenix Road. Turn right on North Phoenix Road. Hillcrest Cemetery will be on your left after you pass Coal Mine Road. Hillcrest Cemetery was established in 1933. Location: N42° 17.953′ W122° 48.878′





HILL DUNN FAMILY CEMETERY also known as KINGSBURY or SODA SPRINGS CEMETERY

From Ashland, take Highway 66 and pass the entrance to Emigrant Lake. Continue driving to the next access to Emigrant Lake which is a dirt road. Turn left towards Emigrant Lake. The cemetery is by the Lake. Hill Dunn Cemetery was established in 1853. Location: N42° 08.658′ W122° 37.290′

JACKSONVILLE CEMETERY

From Medford go west on Main Street (this becomes the Jacksonville Hwy). After entering the Jacksonville city limits turn right on E Street. The street ends at the gate of the cemetery. Jacksonville Cemetery was established in 1859. Location: N42° 18.999′ W122° 58.071′





JOHN MATHEWS PIONEER CEMETERY

From Medford, go north on Hwy 62. Beyond Eagle Point and the Linn Road intersection, turn right on Crystal Drive. The cemetery is up the hill from the intersection. The John Mathews Pioneer Cemetery was established in 1857. Location: N42° 28.697′ W122° 48.494′

JOHNSON CEMETERY

From Medford, go north on Hwy 62 past Shady Cove city limits. The Johnson Cemetery is on the left just before crossing the Rogue River in Shady Cove. The Johnson Cemetery was established in 1908. Location: N42° 36.754′ W122° 48.753′

LOG TOWN CEMETERY

From Medford, take Main St. east to Jacksonville (Main St. becomes the Jacksonville Highway) In Jacksonville, turn right on California Street. (California St. becomes Hwy 238). Log Town Cemetery will be on the left just before you enter Ruch. Log Town Cemetery was established in 1862. Location: N42° 15.482′ W123° 01.681′

MEDFORD FIRST CHRISTIAN CHURCH MEMORIAL GARDEN

From Medford, go north on Riverside to East McAndrews Rd. Turn right and go under I-5. Continue on East McAndrews until you reach Crater Lake Ave. Turn left onto Crater Lake Ave. The church and Memorial Garden are on the right at the NE corner of Crater Lake Ave. and Brookhurst St. The Memorial Garden was established in 2001. Location: N42° 20.859' W122° 51.385'



MEMORY GARDENS MEMORIAL PARK

From Medford, go West on W. Main St. to Arnold Lane. Turn left on Arnold Lane and Continue South to Bellinger Lane. Memory Gardens is on the left at the NE corner of Arnold Lane and Bellinger Lane. Memory Gardens was founded in 1954. Location: N42° 18.541' W122° 55.942'





MISSOURI FLAT CEMETERY

From Medford, take Highway 238 to North Applegate Road. Turn right onto North Applegate Road. The cemetery will be on your left after 4.5 miles. Missouri Flat Cemetery was established in 1864. Location: N42° 17.931′ W123° 13.158′

MORSE FAMILY PLOT

From Ashland, go North on North Main St. (Hwy 99) to South Valley View Rd. Turn right on South Valley View Rd. and cross over I-5 (exit #19). The road name changes to North Valley View Rd. Turn left on West Valley View Rd. Turn right on Staples Lane. Morse Family Plot was established in 1921. Location: N42° 14.446′ W122° 44.853′





MOUNTAIN VIEW CEMETERY and RESTHAVEN MAUSOLEUM

From downtown Ashland take North Main Street south to Siskiyou Blvd and continue until you reach Ashland Street. Take a left on Ashland Street (Hwy 66 East). The cemetery is at the intersection of Hwy 66 East and Normal Avenue on the left hand side. Mountain View Cemetery was established in 1904. Location: N42° 11.1325′ W122° 40.970′

MOUNTAIN VIEW IOOF CEMETERY and MAUSOLEUM

From downtown Ashland take North Main Street south to Siskiyou Blvd and continue until you reach Ashland Street. Take a left on Ashland Street (Hwy 66 East). The cemetery is at the intersection of Hwy 66 East and Normal Avenue on the right hand side. Mountain View Cemetery was established in 1904. Location: N42° 11.081′ W122° 40.979′



NYE CEMETERY

From Trail, drive north on Hwy 62. Turn left onto Ulrich Road (north of Cascade Gorge Road) and travel 0.45 miles. The road will make a 90 degree turn to the left. Follow the road 0.1 mile and the road will make a 90 degree turn to the right. The cemetery is in the woods to the right. Nye Cemetery was established in 1946. Location: N42° 43.25′ W122° 34.133′





NYE PHIPPS PIONEER CEMETERY also known as NYE FAMILY PLOT or FLOUNCE ROCK CEMETERY From Trail, drive north on Hwy 62. Turn left onto Ulrich Road (north of Cascade Gorge Road) and travel for 0.45 miles. The cemetery is on the right. The earliest burial in the Nye Phipps Pioneer Cemetery was in 1895. Location: N42° 43.230′ W122° 34.091′

PANKEY CEMETERY also known as SAM'S VALLEY CEMETERY

From Medford, take Hwy 62 north. Beyond Eagle Point, take Hwy 234 to the left. Take the Old Sams Valley Road to the right. Turn right onto Ramsey Road. The Pankey Cemetery will be on the right. The Pankey Cemetery was established in 1863. Location: N42° 29.902′ W122° 59.647′






PHOENIX PIONEER CEMETERY th

From Medford, take Hwy 99 south to 4 Street in Phoenix. Turn right on 4 Street and then turn right on Church Street. The Cemetery will be on the left. Phoenix Pioneer Cemetery was established in 1857. Location: N42° 16.614′ W122° 49.193′

PINEHURST CEMETERY

From Ashland take Hwy 66 east to Lincoln. The cemetery is on the Box R Ranch property. Location: N42° 7.567′ W122° 22.317′





ROCK POINT IOOF CEMETERY

From Medford, drive north on I-5 to exit # 43. Exit to the right and then right again on Hwy 99. Cross the Rogue River and continue right on Hwy 234. Enter the Rock Point Pioneer Cemetery which is on the left and just across the railroad tracks. The Rock Point IOOF Cemetery is on the east side of the property. Rock Point IOOF Cemetery was established in 1874. Location: N42° 26.150′ W123° 05.052′

ROCK POINT PIONEER CEMETERY

From Medford, drive north on I-5 to exit # 43. Exit to the right and then right again on Hwy 99. Cross the Rogue River and continue right on Hwy 234. Enter the Rock Point Pioneer Cemetery which is on the left and just across the railroad tracks. The earliest known burial at the Rock Point Pioneer Cemetery was in 1864. Location: N42° 26.114′ W123° 05.156′





SCENIC HILLS MEMORIAL PARK

From Ashland, go south on Main Street to East Main. Continue on East Main until you cross I-5. Turn left on East Hills Drive. The cemetery will be on your left. Scenic Hills Memorial Park was established in 1964. Location: N42° 11.834′ W122° 40.077′

SISKIYOU MEMORIAL PARK

From the center of Medford, go south on Central (Hwy 99). Turn left on 10 street.

Cross Bear Creek and continue on 10 Street. Bear to the right and you will be on Siskiyou Boulevard. Enter the roundabout and exit on Siskiyou Blvd. on the other side. The Siskiyou Memorial Park will be on the right. Siskiyou Memorial Park Cemetery was established in 1932. Location: N42° 19.26383' W122° 50.9412'





STEAMBOAT CEMETERY aka CARBERRY or COPPER CEMETERY

From Medford, take Main Sreet east to Jacksonville (Main St. becomes the Jacksonville Hwy). In Jacksonville, turn right on California Street (California St. becomes Hwy 238). Take Hwy 238 to Ruch. In Ruch turn left on Applegate Road. In about 18 miles, take a right on Carberry Road. The cemetery will be in 7.6 miles. Steamboat Cemetery was established in 1896. Location: N42° 4.467′ W122° 12.500′

STEARNS CEMETERY

From Talent, go south on Hwy 99. Turn right onto Rapp Road. Follow Rapp Road over the railroad tracks and until it makes a 90 degree left turn. Now the road is named Wagner Creek Road. Take the second right which is Anderson Creek Road. The cemetery is on the left after passing Allen Lane. Stearns Cemetery was established in 1857. Location: N42° 13.523′ W122° 47.883′





STERLINGVILLE CEMETERY aka STERLING CEMETERY

From Jacksonville, take Highway 238 west and turn left on Cady Road. Then turn right onto Sterling Creek Road. Travel about six miles. The cemetery is on the left side of the road and it is ¼ of a mile before Griffin Lane. Location: N42° 12.878′ W122° 57.132′

TRAIL CEMETERY

From Medford, take Hwy 62 to the north. After Shady Cove, turn left on Main Street in Trail. Take a left onto Trail Creek Road. The cemetery is about ½ mile on the left. Trail Cemetery was established around 1900.





WELLS FAMILY PLOT

From downtown Ashland take North Main Street south to Siskiyou Blvd. Continue until you reach Ashland Street. Take a left on Ashland Street (Hwy 66 East). Continue on Hwy 66 over I-5. The cemetery is on the right at the intersection of Hwy 66 and Crowson Road. The earliest burial in the Wells Family Plot was in 1894. Location: N42° 10.616′ W122° 39.090′

WESTMINSTER MEMORIAL GARDEN

From the center of Medford, go south on Central (Hwy 99). Turn left on 10 Street. Cross Bear Creek and continue on 10 Street. Bear to the right and you will be on Siskiyou Boulevard. Enter the roundabout and exit on Siskiyou Boulevard on the other side. Turn left on Groveland Avenue. The Westminster Memorial Garden is at the corner of Groveland Avenue and Oakwood. Location: N42° 19.5759 W122° 50.7434





WOODVILLE CEMETERY

From Medford, take I-5 north and take exit #48. Turn right on Depot Street. Turn right on East Main Street. Turn left on Wards Creek Road. Woodville Cemetery will be on the left. Woodville Cemetery was established in 1889. Location: N42° 26.008′ W123° 09.580′
